Every Friday and Saturday night between 10pm and 3am a small team of City Pastors from a range of Christian churches walk the streets of Bath city centre to offer practical and prayerful help to anyone who may need us.

The needs are very varied:

Someone who is lost or become separated from friends.

A rough sleeper needs a hot drink and a blanket.

A 'clubber' has drunk too much.

Someone needs a friendly face and a listening ear.

There is tension in the air, we provide a calming presence.

We do this simply by being where the people are, keeping our eyes and ears open and working with other night time agencies via radio and CCTV.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

Come and join one of our teams as an Observer and you can see for yourself what being a Bath City Pastor is all about.

Contact our Coordinator whose details are on the back of this leaflet, or if you know someone who is a City Pastor, ask to join them on a shift.

After this, if you feel you'd like to be a City Pastor, then we would love to have you onboard and you can start the simple 3 step process to join us.

WHAT IS THE COMMITMENT I WILL NEED TO MAKE?

Initially this will be the induction 3 step process. Once you have completed this process you are ready to join us as a uniformed Bath City Pastor, ideally patrolling once a month. There will also be ongoing training for all City Pastors.

THREE STEPS TO JOIN US AS A BATH STREET PASTOR



STEP 1

Initial contact
Join us for a night as an observer
Receive application pack



STEP 2

Training session
Receive handbook
Complete application
Continue shifts as an observer



STEP 3

Short interview
DBS Clearance
Receive uniform

WILL IT COST ME ANYTHING TO JOIN?

No, we won't charge you to join.

We do ask, if you are able, to consider making a contribution towards the £50 cost of training and your uniform.

We also suggest that you approach your church and ask for their support, ideally as a regular giving commitment which will also support the future work of the Bath City Pastors.

CAN ANYONE JOIN?

The team is made up of Christians who are actively involved in the Christian community. We welcome anyone over the age of 18 who feels called to this ministry of Bath City Pastors and is happy to make a regular commitment.
